

Ordinance Number 36

An Ordinance Regulating Draying Within The City Of Washburn  
Mc Lean County North Dakota

Be it ordained by The City Commission

Section 1. (License Running Dray For Hire)

No person, persons, firm or corporation shall persue or carry on the business of draying for hire within the City of Washburn without first obtaining a license to operate the same.

Section 2. (License required under Sec. 1)

That the license required under section 1 of this ordinance shall be as follows, to-wit:

\$15.00 per year for the first wagon or auto-truck and \$5.00 per year for each additional wagon or auto-truck.

Section. 3 (License, How Obtained.)

Any person, persons, firm or corporation desiring to obtain a license under this ordinance shall in person or by his agent make his application in writing to the City Auditor and upon payment to the City Treasurer of such sum as shall cover the period for which the license id desired, shall receive from the Treasurer a receipt thereof, specifying the purpose for which same was paid and upon filing said receipt with the City Auditor shall receive a license signed by the President of the Commission and counter-signed by the City Auditor, authorizing the holder to dray for hire within said City for such length of time, not to exceed one year, as may be specified therein.

Section 4.- Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 and not more than \$100.00 and cost, for each and every such offense.
