WHEREAS, the McLean County Sheriff's Department deputies wear the uniform and badge with pride and are dedicated to the protection of our families, homes, and community; and

WHEREAS, thousands of law enforcement officers across the nation, including those in McLean County, wake up every morning to selflessly serve and protect, knowing the risks they face, and that their passing would shake the hearts of their loved ones and community; and

WHEREAS, North Dakota recognizes the traumatic events a law enforcement officer may encounter during their career, and the City of Washburn commits to supporting the McLean County Sheriff's Department with gratitude for their continuous service to our community; and

WHEREAS, throughout this week, and especially on Peace Officers' Memorial Day, we honor the memory of those heroes who have fallen in the line of duty and recognize all those who put themselves at risk every day in the fight against crime, violence and terrorism;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Commissioner Keith Hapip Jr, on behalf of this Commision, do hereby proclaim May 11 through May 17, 2025, as National Police Week in Washburn, and publicly salute the service of the McLean County Sheriff's Department and law enforcement officers in our community and in communities across the nation.

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED, that May 15, 2025, shall be Peace Officers' Memorial Day in the City of Washburn, and the United States Flag shall be flown at half-staff at all City facilities on this date.
